

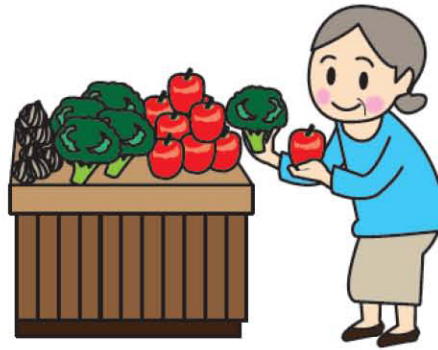

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Plenty of	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• enough of something ex: I have plenty of time.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• too much	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• more than enough of something (uncountable) ex: I don't want too much sugar in my tea.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• too many	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• more than enough of something (countable in plural form) ex: There are too many people in the train.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• all of / all	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 100 % of something ex: All of my paper are gone.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• a little	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• small amount of something (uncountable) ex: Can I have a little sugar, please?
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• a few	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• small amount of something (countable in plural forms) ex: The market is just a few meters away.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• none of	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• nothing at all ex: None of the class pass the exam.
